The Sail Past will commence at approximately 13:15. Participating boats are requested to be in their designated assembly areas by 12:40 and wait for instructions from Boonoorong operating on VHF channel 77.

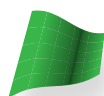
The official boat, Kingfisher II, will be anchored near SYC crowding mark. Participating boats will proceed from their designated assembly area in the order set out above, passing between Kingfisher II and an orange inflatable buoy with a black band laid to leeward of Kingfisher II, giving three cheers to the Commodore.

Lead boats will be called on VHF channel 77 in the order set out above to commence their sail past.

Boats in each group or division should follow their boat in a single line at a safe distance.

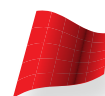
Each succeeding group / division should follow the last of the preceding group / division.

We request that spinnakers are not to be used in winds above 20 knots.

Assemble to the south of the harbour west of the Yorkies reef

### On Shore

Code flag N will be displayed both from the Start Tower and the Ken King Centre.

The Commodore will visit each boat in the marina.

### On Water

Code flag N will be displayed both from Endeavour IV and Boonoorong.

All boats to return to shore/marina immediately.
