**Trailer and Trolley Hard Standing:**

- 9.1 The Club may at any time grant to a Member authority to store in the Yard a yacht on a Trailer or Hard Stand Trolley. Such authority shall include permission to utilise launching and recovery facilities as appropriate to the type of yacht without further additional fee.
- 9.2 Applications for allocated positions for Trailer or Hard Stand yachts shall be made in writing to the Chief Executive Officer. Allocated positions for Trailer or Hard Stand yachts are not transferable.
- 9.3 A Trailer or Hard Stand Trolley yacht shall be stored only in the position as allocated by the Club who will reserve the right to change the allocated position/s from time to time.
- 9.4 Trailer and Hard Stand Trolley sites shall only be used for the yacht designated to that position.
- 9.5 Allocated positions for Trailer or Hard Stand yachts that are not used by the allocated yacht for any period that the Club considers reasonable may be re-allocated to another yacht on a temporary or permanent basis.
- 9.6 Rental for Trailer and Hard Stand Trolley positions shall be charged to the authorised occupants accounts during the first month of each quarter of each year.
- 9.7 Any temporary rental fees will be charged on a monthly advance basis and will be credited to the Club general revenue account.
- 9.8 A Member who sells or otherwise disposes of a yacht allocated a Trailer or Hard Stand Trolley position must remove that yacht within 14 days of such sale or disposal and inform the SYC Office immediately thereafter.
- 9.9 Persons allocated a Hard Stand Trolley site shall ensure that ladders for accessing the boat are safe and fit for the purpose and properly maintained.
- 9.10 Trailer and Hard Stand areas must be kept clean at all times and free of gear, lines, hoses, power cords, sails, boat covers, tools and the like at any time when the crew of the yacht are not present.
- 9.11 Only minor cleaning maintenance is permitted in the Trailer and Hard Stand Trolley areas.
- 9.12 Any boat owner wishing to undertake major maintenance for a yacht allocated to a Trailer or Hard Stand Trolley position shall make application to the Marina and Yard Manager who will direct where such work may be undertaken.
- 9.13 Cranes on the Hard Stand area shall be used only for launching and retrieval of yachts stored on the Hard Stand, unless prior permission is granted by the Marina and Yard Manager.
- 9.14 Cranes on the Hard Stand area shall be operated only under the control of persons specifically authorised by the Marina and Yard Manager.
- 9.15 Authorised Hard Stand Crane Operators shall ensure that at all times the lifting apparatus attached to the crane, including slings, shackles, anchor points and the like, is properly maintained and capable of carrying the load to be lifted.
- 9.16 The safe working load of Hard Stand cranes, as posted on each crane, shall not be exceeded.
- 9.17 No person shall remain aboard a yacht whilst it is being lifted by a Hard Stand crane.

- Cranes on the Hard Stand area shall be operated only under the control of persons specifically authorised by the Marina & Yard Manager. (By-Law 9.14).
- Authorised Hard Stand Crane Operators shall ensure that at all times the lifting apparatus attached to the crane, including slings, shackles, anchor points and the like, is properly maintained and capable of carrying the load to be lifted (By-Law 9.15)
- The safe working load of the Hard Stand Crane, as posted on each crane shall not be exceeded. (By-Law 9.16).
- No person shall remain aboard a yacht whilst it is being lifted by a Hard Stand Crane. (By-Law 9.17).
