NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Clarification of “Finish” when sailing around fixed marks at SYC

Issued 14th April 2010

RRS definition of “finish” states:

“A boat ***finishes*** when any part of her hull, or crew or equipment in normal position, crosses the finishing line **in the direction of course from the last mark.....”**

When sailing at SYC around fixed marks, usually it is clear from which side the finishing line should be approached, except in case when the last mark is either SYC2 or SYC6. (applicable when a course is shortened)

For the avoidance of doubt, when boats are finishing from the direction of SYC2 or SYC6, they should leave mark SYC4 (finishing mark) to Starboard.
