



## **Supplementary Sailing Instructions for**

### **Ullman S38 Series Race to be conducted at Royal Brighton Yacht Club 11 December 2011**

All races will be governed by the current version of The RBYC Sailing Instructions Issued October 2008 except as amended below:

#### **1 Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)  
The Prescriptions of Yachting Australia (YA) shall apply.  
YA Special Regulations Part 1 Category 6 will apply.  
The S38 class rules will apply.

#### **5. Schedule of Races is replaced by:**

11 December 2011    3 races            1000

#### **6. Class Flags is replaced by:**

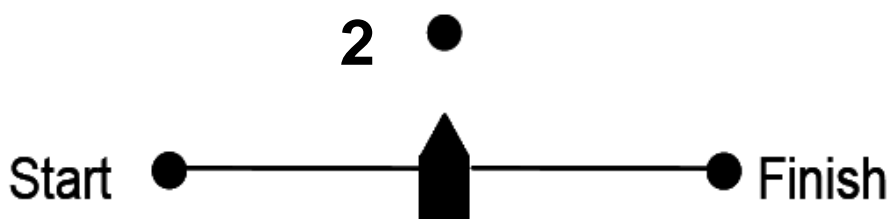
The Class Flag will be flag "S38".

**9. Courses is replaced by:**

The diagrams below show the course configuration, including the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

The race committee signal vessel may display the approximate compass bearing from the Starting Line to Mark 1.

Course 1      Start – 1 – 2 – 1 – Finish  
Course 2      Start – 1 – 2 – 1 – 2 – 1 – Finish

**10. Marks is replaced by:**

Mark 1 will be a Pink Inflatable buoy

Marks 2 will be an Orange inflatable buoy

The Change of course Mark, as provided in instruction 15, will a yellow inflatable buoy.

The starting and finishing marks will be inflatable yellow buoys

**22. Radio Transmission**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

RBYC Race Control will monitor and use VHF Channel 77 during races.

It is recommended that all boats monitor and transmit on VHF Channel 77 and 16.
