# **NOTICE OF RACE**

**16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of October 2010**

The Organising Authority for this regatta is the Sandringham Yacht Club Inc.  
Sandringham Yacht Club invites entries for the **2010 SAIL SANDY REGATTA** to be conducted on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> of October 2010.

## 1. RULES

This Regatta will be governed by the (ISAF) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia (YA).  
YA Addendum A. Part 2 will apply (National Jury applied for)

## 2. ADVERTISING

The Regatta is classified as a Category "A" event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 Advertising Code.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES

- a) The regatta is open to all monohull **Off the Beach** classes with a listed YV yardstick. All boats must comply with their current class rules.
- b) Helmspersons and their crew shall be members of a YA affiliated Yacht Club.
- c) Eligible boats are encouraged to enter online <http://www.syc.com.au/off-the-beach-news/sail-sandy-regatta/> or on the attached Entry Form which shall be faxed, mailed or delivered to:

Before 1700hrs Wednesday **13<sup>th</sup> of October to be eligible for the Early Bird Fee.**  
(All fees must be submitted together with the entry form).

- d) Entry will not be accepted after 1100hrs on Saturday the 16<sup>th</sup> of October 2010.

## 4. FEES

**Early Bird Registration Fee                    \$55.00**  
(If registering prior to 1700hrs Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2010)  
SYC Junior Members entry fee: \$40.00

**Full Entry Fee                                    \$70.00**  
All cheques are to be made payable to "*Sandringham Yacht Club*"

- a) Registration will take place in the Training Auditorium located adjacent to the Boating Department of Sandringham Yacht Club on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2010 from 0800hrs until 1100hrs.
- b) All entries shall have a current Public Liability Insurance policy covering the use of the boat while racing.

## 5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- a) At Registration all competitors and officials will be issued with a Honorary membership of the Sandringham Yacht Club for the duration of the regatta.

Honorary membership will be issued on the basis that competitors and officials respect the rules and regulations of SYC Honorary Membership, this privilege may be revoked at any time.

Competitors and officials are to present themselves to the Registration Office on arrival to be issued with their Honorary Membership pass.

- b) There are 8 races scheduled for this event

Note: There will be no warning signal after 1500hrs, there are no resails.

## **6. MEASUREMENT**

Each competitor shall ensure their boat has a valid measurement / rating Certificate. And these should be readily available in the case of a dispute.

## **7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available upon completion of registration at Sandringham Yacht Club. All regatta updates and amendments to SI's will be posted on the SYC web site ([www.syc.com.au](http://www.syc.com.au)) and on the Official Notice Board.

## **8. RACING AREA**

The racing will be held on Port Phillip in the vicinity of the Sandringham Yacht Club.

## **9. COURSES**

Trapezoid and windward leeward type courses as described in the Sailing Instructions.

## **10. SCORING SYSTEM**

The Low Point Scoring System in Appendix A will apply. Divisional using yardstick / class for 10 or more entries

## **11. SUPPORT BOATS**

- a) Coach/support Boats shall conspicuously display identification of the team being coached.
- b) The Organising Authority will provide berths for visiting coach/support boats under 6m on request by completion of the form within this NOR.
- c) Unless directed by the Race Management Team and or Umpires, or to render immediate assistance in the interests of safety, team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall not enter the Course Area where boats are racing, as defined in the Sailing Instructions and shall stay more than 50 metres clear of any mark of the course from the time of the preparatory signal for the first flight to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.
- c) Any interference by a coach or coach/support boat with the racing or event organization may result in a penalty applied at the discretion of the event umpires to the appropriate skipper or team.
- e) All coach/support boats shall comply with the SYC Special Notice of Requirements for Coach/Support Boats and complete the Coach Boat Agreement form – *Attachment A*. All support personnel will comply with the YA "Coaches code of conduct".

## 12. PRIZES

Trophies may be awarded to:

- (a) Class prize 1-3 for 10 or more entries
- (b) Division 1-3 on yardstick
- (c) Regatta winners 1-3 using class & yardstick.

Other trophies may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

A Presentation ceremony will be held on the northern podium of the main clubhouse as soon as possible after the last race on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2010.

## 12. SAFETY

Officials may carry out "spot checks" from time to time. Any boat that does not fully comply with all Class rules and YA Safety Regulations may be subject to protest.

## 13. ENTRY DISCLAIMER

It is the competitor's decision to enter the Regatta or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the Regatta is at their exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entry in the Regatta competitors shall indemnify the Organising Authority, Sail Sandy and the Host Club, their officers, members, servants and agents in respect to all claims and demands of whatever nature (such as loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property and all other possible claims) which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the Regatta.

## 14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

## **SPECIAL NOTICE OF REQUIREMENTS FOR COACH/SUPPORT BOATS**

Coach / support boats which wish to enter and use the Sandringham marina during the Championship must comply with the following:

1. Complete the attached form in full and return it to the Boating Department before arriving at Sandringham Yacht Club – boats will not be allowed into the yard or marina until this form has been completed, checked and verified;
2. Unless directed by the Race Management Team and or Umpires, or to render immediate assistance in the interests of safety, team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall not enter the Course Area where boats are racing, as defined in the Sailing Instructions and shall stay more than 50 metres clear of any mark of the course from the time of the preparatory signal for the first flight to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment;
3. When requested by the Race Management Team and or Umpires render immediate assistance as and when directed;
4. All coach boats are required to have a VHF radio, and maintain a listening watch on the channels specified by the Race Management Team and Umpires;
5. All team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall identify themselves by flying a flag of not less than 300mm x 300mm displaying the boat, club, class or state they represent.
6. All support boats are required to hold Third Party Liability Insurance of not less than \$5,000,000 and written evidence of this must be delivered to the Boating Department, Sandringham Yacht Club. Written confirmation should be obtained from your insurer that your private pleasure craft policy will cover your boat whilst being used in this capacity. Failing to comply with the insurance requirement may render the boat unable to participate or assist any boat nominated for the Championship, and will therefore be denied access to the yard or marina;
7. The penalty for failing to comply with the above requirements may, after protest, be the disqualification of all boats associated with the infringing support personnel.

### TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The craft shall only be moored in the location as directed by SYC staff or representative. Specifically vessels are not to be moored at the crane or launching ramp pontoons **at any time**.
2. Unleaded and diesel fuel is available at the Fuel jetty, however a prepaid card must be purchased from SYC office reception prior to tying up. Coach Boats are requested to only refuel before racing each day.  
\* Race Management and Umpire vessels will have priority refueling access after each day's racing.
3. Vehicles and trailers must be removed from the yard and parked outside SYC premises on Treybit Reserve immediately after launching.
4. All boats must have a VHF radio, and maintain a listening watch on the channels specified by the Race Management and Umpire Team. All skippers must attend a briefing with Race Management and umpire Team at a *time to be advertised* for other instructions.
5. Coach / support boats must have documented evidence showing current public liability insurance to the value of \$5,000,000.
6. Coach / support boats will assist in the event of an emergency if directed to do so by the Race Management and or Umpire Team.
7. Coach / support boats may not enter the race area, unless directed to do so by the Race Management and or Umpire Team.
